## NON HUNTING ACTIVITIES

---

### VISIT PUNTA WALICHU

Visit the ancient caves and their surroundings. Situate yourself in the geographical and historical space and learn information about how ancient civilizations made the paintings on the cave's walls.

You will also be able to get to know the Ahónikenk people and their traditions. A cultural walk on the shores of the Argentine lake between stone corridors in the Patagonian steppe.



## PERITO MORENO GLACIER

Visitors must travel 80 km to the walkway area in front of the Perito Moreno Glacier if they want to take a glimpse of the eighth World Wonder.

This glacier originates on the Southern Patagonian ice field. In its descent, it reaches the southern arm of Argentino Lake, with a front view of 5 km in length, it emerges over the water with a height of about 60 km.

Visitors must walk through the different-level corridors to enjoy the glacier from all angles.



## TREKKING IN EL CHALTEN

In this impressive natural setting you have multiple and varied options for walking, climbing, hiking or trekking. The strong emotions begin long before you arrive. They start when in the distance you can see the peaks of Mount Fitz Roy, Chalten mountain and glaciers that make this corner of Patagonia one of its kind.



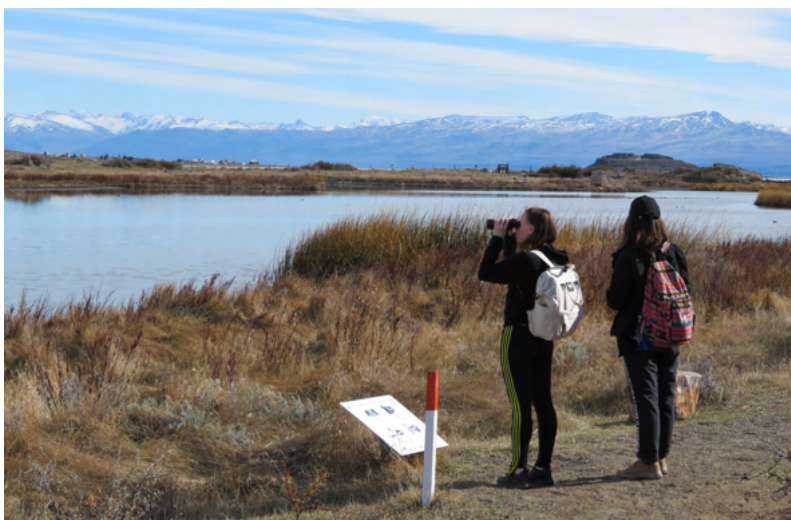
## MOUNTAIN PARK CALAFATE

El Calafate Mountain Park is a center for recreational activities that offers programs in summer and winter. Located 15 km from the center of El Calafate on the Huyliche hill and at about 1050 m above sea level, Mountain Park offers skiing, snowmobiling, tubing, quad/bike adventures and trekking depending on the time of year you decide to visit.



## VISIT LAGUNA NIMEZ

The Laguna Nimez Reserve is located very close to the center of the city of El Calafate and it is a recommended activity to do as a family. The 3 kilometers circuit is done on foot and you can get to Lake Argentino following it.

### KOSTEN AIKE

"Kosten Aike offers an unbeatable location in El Calafate, just 2 blocks from the Shopping Center and a few minutes from the International Airport.

The hotel takes its name from the voices Kosten (Wind) and Aike (place), but in addition to its name tehuelche, all bedspreads, curtains, folders, fittings and plastic compositions were specially made by prominent Argentine artists recreating the ancestral designs of the town Tehuelche, recognized for its high aesthetic concept and perfect geometry.

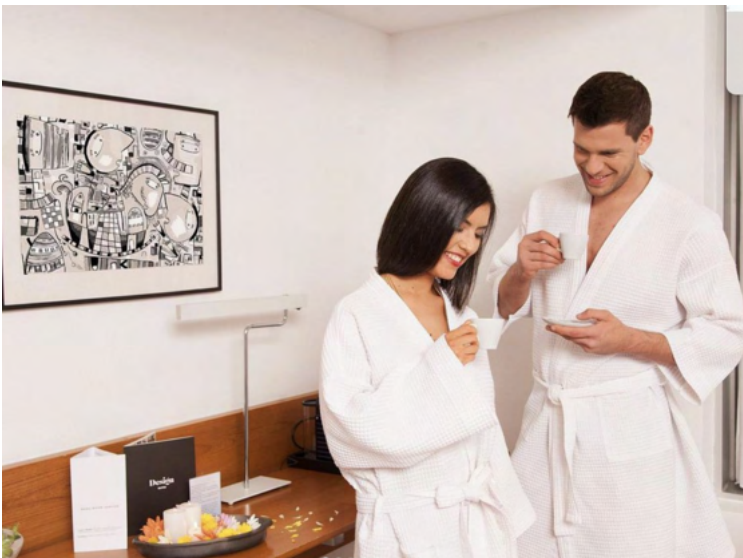


## DESIGN SUITES

Design Suites Calafate is elegantly decorated, 3 km from the center of Calafate and offers an indoor pool, sauna and spa. In addition, there is a gym and you can book spa treatments. Free Wi-Fi access is also available.



Design Calafate offers rooms with flat-screen cable TV and large windows that let in plenty of light. Some suites have whirlpool and panoramic views of the lake. The establishment houses an a la carte restaurant and a bar serving food and drinks from morning until late at night.





## LOS SAUCES

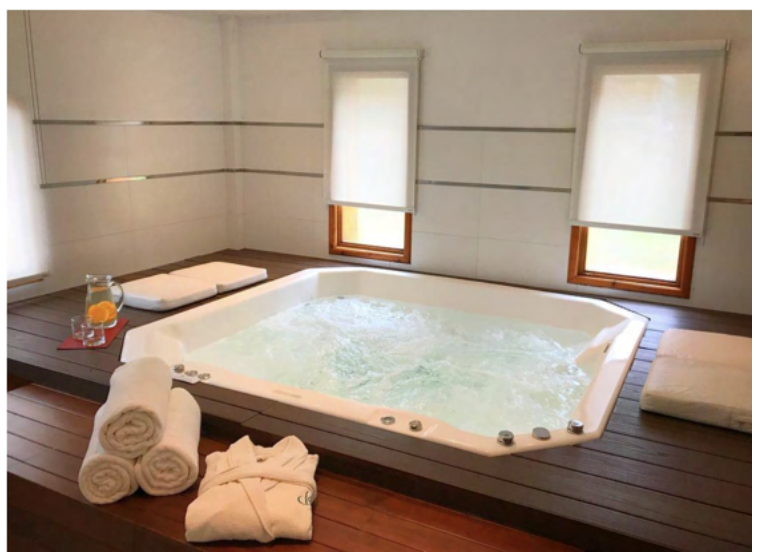

## WHERE TO EAT

---

### LA TABLITA

If you love meat, this is the place to eat at when you are in El Calafate! It is a carnivore's paradise and is known to have the best steaks in town as well as lamb, other meats and beef cuts.

Reservations are a MUST, otherwise you could be waiting a long time or turned away. The airy dining room is comfortable and bustling and the service is very attentive.

The meat is not the only thing that is good here. Anything you order here is fantastic - dessert, drinks, etc. A must when you are in this city!



## PURA VIDA

Three levels of dining with a fun and eclectic atmosphere, Pura Vida serves a home cooking menu like empanadas, canelones, pies and stew to compensate your big ice hike earlier in the day. Pura Vida also has a vegetarian menu, with brown rice and wok veggies or various salads.



## CASIMIRO BIGUÁ PARRILLA & ASADOR / *Steak House*

A staple in the Argentina diet is the parrilla, and Parrilla PUMA, the recently opened restaurant in El Calafate is already making noise around town. The restaurant prides itself on providing the best quality of meat, spiced and cooked to perfect to ensure a home-style Argentinian parrilla to welcome travellers to the cultures of Argentina.



## MI RANCHO / Restaurant Patagonico

Inspired and intimate, Mi Rancho serves up oversized osso buco, delicious braided pastas stuffed with king crab, divine salads and sweetbreads with wilted spinach on toast.
